

## Recessed Shelf Installation

Silicone sealant is easy to install and finish when you are properly equipped. Follow these guidelines to improve the ease and quality of your installation.

1. Use color match silicone applied to the reverse side of the flange to secure the recessed shelf in position.
2. Only use silicone that is 100% silicone and formulated with mildew and mold resistance additives.
3. Install silicone sealant using the PUSH method (cut a small opening in the tube tip or nozzle and force the silicone into the cavity by using a pushing movement with the caulk gun).
4. Immediately mist the surface of the silicone and the reverse side of the flange with silicone tooling mist.
5. Use the white finishing/shaping tool to shape the silicone to the desired finish.



6. Remove any collected silicone from the tool by wiping with a clean white rag.
7. Lightly misting the tool will allow the silicone to be removed easily from the tool.

*Special Note:*

*Do not work the silicone any more than necessary. Make only one pass if at all possible. Silicone begins to skin over within only a minute or two. Do not install more silicone than you can work quickly. Silicone can not be successfully worked once it has begun to cure (begun to develop a skin).*
